

## ANTIPHONS FOR THE CIRCUMCISION OF CHRIST

(Only chanted on January 1)

### First Antiphon (Psalm 65, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. Ἀλαλάξατε τῷ Κυρίῳ πᾶσα ἡ γῆ.
2. Ψάλατε δὴ τῷ ὀνόματι αὐτοῦ. δότε δόξαν αἰνέσει αὐτοῦ.
3. Εἶπατε τῷ Θεῷ· ὡς φοβερὰ τὰ ἔργα σου.

Refrain: Ταῖς πρεσβείαις τῆς Θεοτόκου...

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. Make a joyful shout to God, all the earth!
2. Sing out the honor of His name; make His praise glorious.
- 3 Say to God, "How awesome are Your works!

Refrain: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos...

### Second Antiphon (Psalms 95, 67, 49, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. Εὐφραινέσθωσαν οἱ οὐρανοὶ καὶ ἀγαλλιέσθω ἡ γῆ.
2. Ἄσατε τῷ Θεῷ, ψάλατε τῷ ὀνόματι αὐτοῦ.
3. Ἐκ Σιών ἡ εὐπρέπεια τῆς ὠραιότητος αὐτοῦ.

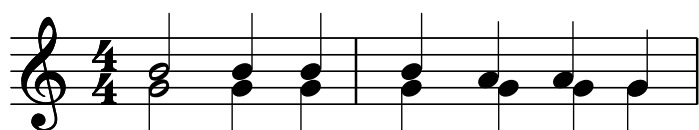

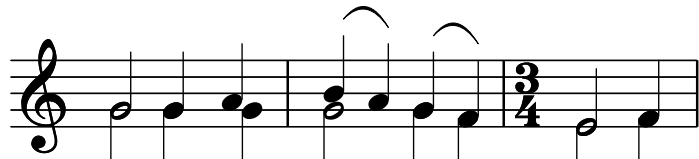

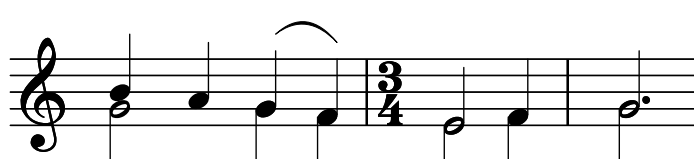

*Repeat the Apolytikion of the Circumcision of Christ,  
and then chant the Apolytikion of St. Basil*
