ANTIPHONS FOR THE NATIVITY OF THE THEOTOKOS

September 8

(Chant antiphons on Sundays from September 8 to 12.)

First Antiphon (Psalms 131 and 86, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

- 1. Μνήσθητι, Κύριε, τοῦ Δαυΐδ καὶ πάσης τῆς πραότητος αὐτοῦ.
- 2. Ίδοὺ ἠκούσαμεν αὐτὴν ἐν Ἐφραθᾳ, εὕρομεν αὐτὴν ἐν τοῖς πεδίοις τοῦ δρυμοῦ.
- 3. Δεδοξασμένα έλαλήθη περί σοῦ ἡ πόλις τοῦ Θεοῦ.

Refrain: Ταῖς πρεσβείαις τῆς Θεοτόκου...

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

- 1. Lord, remember David And all his afflictions.
- 2. Behold, we heard of it in Ephrathah; we found it in the fields of the woods.
- 3. Glorious things are spoken of you, O city of God!

Refrain: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos...

Second Antiphon (Psalm 131, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):


- 1. Ύμοσε Κύριος τῷ Δαυΐδ ἀλήθειαν καὶ οὐ μὴ ἀθετήσει αὐτήν.
- 2. Έκ καρποῦ τῆς κοιλίας σου θήσομαι ἐπὶ τοῦ θρόνου σου.
- 3. Ἐκεῖ ἐξανατελῶ κέρας τῷ Δαυΐδ, ἡτοίμασα λύχνον τῷ χριστῷ μου.

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

Refrain:

- 1 The Lord has sworn in truth to David; He will not turn from it.
- 2. Their sons also shall sit upon your throne forevermore.
- 3. There I will make the horn of David grow; I will prepare a lamp for My Anointed.



Third Antiphon (Psalm 131, LXX)

Verse (Intoned in Fourth Tone):

Ώδε κατοικήσω, ὅτι ἡρετισάμην αὐτήν. He has desired it for His dwelling place.

Chant the Apolytikion of the Nativity of the Theotokos. Then...

SMALL ENTRANCE HYMN FOR THE DORMITION OF THE THEOTOKOS

Replaces the regular small entrance hymn on the feast and the leave-taking (Sept. 12).
