

## ANTIPHONS FOR WEEKDAYS

### First Antiphon (Psalm 91, LXX)

*Verses (Intone in Second Tone):*

1. Ἀγαθὸν τὸ ἐξομολογεῖσθαι τῷ Κυρίῳ καὶ ψάλλειν τῷ ὀνόματί σου, Ὑψιστε,
2. Τοῦ ἀναγγέλλειν τῷ πρωΐ τὸ ἔλεός σου καὶ τὴν ἀλήθειάν σου κατὰ νύκτα.
3. Ὅτι εὐθὴς Κύριος ὁ Θεὸς ἡμῶν καὶ οὐκ ἔστιν ἀδικία ἐν αὐτῷ.

*Refrain:* Ταῖς πρεσβείαις τῆς Θεοτόκου...

*Verses (Intone in Second Tone):*

1. It is good to give thanks to the Lord, and to sing praises to Your name, O Most High.
2. declare Your lovingkindness in the morning, and Your faithfulness every night.
3. Declare that the Lord is upright; He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.

*Refrain:* Through the intercessions of the Theotokos...

### Second Antiphon (Psalms 92, LXX)

*Verses (Intone in Second Tone):*

1. Ὁ Κύριος ἐβασίλευσεν, εὐπρέπειαν ἐνεδύσατο, ἐνεδύσατο Κύριος δύναμιν καὶ περιεζώσατο.
2. Καὶ γὰρ ἐστερέωσε τὴν οἰκουμένην, ἥτις οὐ σαλευθήσεται.
3. Τῷ οἴκῳ σου πρέπει ἀγίασμα, Κύριε, εἰς μακρότητα ἡμερῶν.
